Commercial/Industrial Drying Tumbler Worldwide Limited Warranty-“CG” Models (Effective January 2001)

Starting Serial Number By Model Available Upon Request

Continental Girbau, Inc. (CGI) warrants all new equipment (and the original parts thereof) manufactured by the manufacturer to be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of three (3) years from date of sale by Continental Girbau, Inc., but in no event more than three and one-half (3-1/2) years from the date of manufacture thereof, except as hereinafter provided.

All CGI equipment and parts are to be purchased solely for commercial or industrial laundry use.

This warranty extends only to the original purchaser of CGI products from a CGI authorized representative or from CGI direct and to those persons who, under applicable state law, are entitled to rely hereon as third party beneficiaries, but in no event shall CGI be liable for property damage sustained by such a third party beneficiary if said applicable state law contemplates such liability but permits its exclusion.

With respect to all new repair or replacement parts for equipment manufactured by the manufacturer for which the three (3) year warranty period has expired or for all new repair or replacement parts for equipment not manufactured by the manufacturer, the warranty period is limited to ninety (90) days from date of sale. The warranty period on each new replacement part furnished by CGI in fulfillment of the warranty on all new replacement parts shall be for the unexpired portion of the original warranty period on the part replaced.

With respect to lint screens, V-belts, gaskets, fuses, and other accessories furnished with the new equipment but not manufactured by the manufacturer, the warranty is limited to one (1) year.

CGI's total liability arising out of the manufacture and sale of new equipment and parts, whether under the warranty or caused by CGI's negligence or otherwise, shall be limited to CGI repairing or replacing, at its option, any defective equipment or parts returned f.o.b. CGI's office, transportation prepaid, within the applicable warranty period and found by CGI to have been defective. The liability of CGI does not include furnishing or paying for any labor such as that required to service, remove, or install; to diagnose troubles; to adjust, remove or replace defective equipment or a part; nor does it include any responsibility for transportation or insurance or other related expense which is involved therein.

With respect to dryers manufactured with a steam coil, said steam coil warranty is subject to a prorated use charge from date of dryer purchase or date of manufacture, whichever is applicable. The distributor making a warranty claim for a steam coil may elect to purchase a new steam coil under CGI's "No Return Program" at a reduced price or return the claimed coil (after receiving written authorization from CGI) at the distributor's expense for evaluation and warranty verification by CGI and the steam coil manufacturer. Steam coils are subject to all provisions of the Dryer Warranty.

Under the "No Return Program," the price to the distributor will be:

1 - 6 months	List less 80% + shipping charges	13-24 months	List less 70% + shipping charges
7- 12 months	List less 75% + shipping charges	25-30 months	List less 63% + shipping charges

If a steam coil is returned for evaluation and found to have failed due to material or workmanship, the price of a replacement steam coil will be:

1 - 12 months	No charge (distributor is responsible for shipping charges)
13 - 24 months	List less 85% + shipping charges
25 - 30 months	List less 78% + shipping charges.

If a steam coil is returned for evaluation and found to have failed due to reasons other than manufactures' defect in material or workmanship (operated under pressures, plumbing or conditions other than those specified by CGI as outlined below), the distributor is not eligible for steam coil pricing under the "No Return Program."

The warranty of CGI is conditioned upon installation and use of its equipment under normal operating conditions. The warranty is void on equipment or parts; that have been subjected to misuse, accident, or negligent damage; operated under loads, pressures, speeds, electrical connections, plumbing, or conditions other than those specified by CGI, operated or repaired with other than genuine CGI replacement parts; damaged by fire, flood, vandalism, or such other causes beyond the control of CGI; altered or repaired in any way that affects the reliability or detracts from its performance; which have had the identification plate or serial number altered, effaced, or removed; or which have been located in the proximity of dry cleaning machines and/or perchloroethylene.

No defective equipment or part may be returned to CGI for repair or replacement without prior written authorization from CGI. Charges for unauthorized repairs will not be accepted or paid by CGI.

The waiver by CGI of any individual term of this warranty shall not operate as a waiver of any other term of this warranty or of any future right, power, or privilege of CGI.

CGI is not responsible for any injury, property damage, or other consequential or incidental damages arising directly or indirectly from the purchase or use of its products or from any defect in material or workmanship.

This limited warranty shall be the limit of Continental's liability for any breach of warranty. Purchaser must notify Continental by registered mail or certified mail, return receipt requested, of a breach of warranty within thirty (30) days after the discovery thereof, but no later than the warranty period, time being of the essence. No allowance shall be granted for any alterations made to the Equipment or Parts by the purchaser without Continental's President's prior, written consent. Continental shall have the discretion to require that the purchaser return to Continental any and all defective Equipment and Parts, or portions thereof. However, no Equipment or Parts shall be returned to Continental for repair or replacement without Continental's President's prior written authorization. The determination by Continental not to require the return to it of defective Equipment or Parts shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of other terms of this limited warranty or of its right to enforce all of the terms of this limited warranty thereafter. Continental does not warrant that the Equipment or Parts shall meet the requirements of any safety code of any state, municipality or other jurisdiction other than the safety agency approvals as stated on the machine. Purchase assumes all risk and liability whatsoever resulting from the use of the Equipment and Parts, whether used singly or in combination with other machines or apparatus.

CGI makes no other express or implied warranty, statutory or otherwise, concerning the equipment, parts or service including, without limitation, a warranty of fitness for a particular purpose, a warranty of merchantability, or any other implied warranties which may arise from course of dealing or usage of trade. The warranties given here are expressly in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied. CGI neither assumes, nor authorizes any person to assume for it, any other warranty or liability in connection with the manufacture, use, or sale of its equipment or parts.

For warranty service, purchaser shall contact the distributor from which the Equipment or Part was originally purchased or the nearest Continental distributor.
